


Respect our workforce

In light of this, we have implemented further measures to bolster the safety of everyone including residents, travelling public and our workforce.

This includes following safety protocols, enhancing signage, and introducing improved traffic management techniques. Through a recent collaboration with Surrey Police, we have observed positive outcomes, with police presence at certain sites leading to the prosecution of two individuals last week. This progress highlights our dedication to ensuring the safety of our workforce and the community.


